Transportation

The following factors are considered when determining delays or closures:

- Safety of the roads specific to bus transportation
- Safety of schools' facilities (appropriate heat, cleared lots, etc.)
- Safety of students traveling to designated bus stops
- Safety of Students in 'non-transported' areas where students either walk or are transported by parents

Facts about WCPS school bus transportation:

- Buses travel over 13,000 miles each day
- Each day 117 county buses start their routes from the Board of Education's lot on Commonwealth Ave
- Buses transport approximately 16,900 students twice each day
- The transportation department employes 234 certified regular route drivers and substitute drivers
- Washington County has 458 square miles of terrain, with 28 miles between the eastern and western borders and 18 miles between the northern and southern borders

Student Services

Student Services programs provide support services to assist students and families. In particular, they encourage school attendance on a regular basis, foster appropriate behavior and help families access community and support services, as needed, to help students succeed in school.

Pupil Personnel Workers (PPW'S) assist schools to promote student attendance. PPW's identify excessive absences, promote positive attitudes toward school attendance, identify and plan interventions and enforce attendance regulations. The PPW's also serve as the school system's liaison to Juvenile Court and other social agencies.

The Student Services staff maintains student enrollment and attendance data, compiles reports for MSDE and completes all pupil accounting records that result in state per pupil finding. They also complete required reports for the Office of Civil Rights related to ethnicity and non-discrimination.

Family Investment Division

The major goal of the Family Investment Program Plan is to help families become independent as soon as possible through employment. Obtaining child support and identifying other resources to help customers become independent are also important parts of our local FIP plan. A customer's full participation in the work activities to gain employment, and cooperation with child support enforcement, is required before his/her application is approved.

The School Family Liaison

This program is a collaborative effort of the Department of Social services and the Washington County Board of Education. The program, initiated with one Diversified School Family Liaison in September 1994, serves children beginning to have problems with attendance, grades and/or behavior that prevent them from being successful in school.

The Families Now Program

Creates a continuum of family preservation services of varying levels of intensity in the ACFS Division. The program is designed to meet the specific needs of individual families whose children are at imminent or high risk of foster care placement or kinship care.

Child Support Enforcement

Our efforts have been aimed at obtaining an order for support as quickly as possible and having the absent parent make regular payments.

Adult, Child, and Family Services Division

Child Protective Services (CPS) Intake is responsible for investigating reports of child abuse and neglect, assessing families' needs for service, and providing court-ordered home studies.

Adult Protective Services

Adult Protective Services investigates reports of abuse, neglect, exploitation, or self-neglect of vulnerable adults. The agency serves adults, 17 years and older, who have mental illness and meet program specific medical necessity criteria as defined by the Maryland State Public Mental Health System.

The Services to Families with Children Program (SFC)

Promotes healthy families by providing a variety of services, at varying levels of intensity. These services include parenting skills training, employment counseling, budget management, housing coordination and linkages with community resources to Washington County Board of Education.
