Proposed Change to Hagerstown Housing Authority's Public Housing Dwelling Lease (Part II)

The Hagerstown Housing Authority (HHA) has reviewed and made a change to its Public Housing Dwelling Lease (Part II). This document governs the continued occupancy of residents in our Public Housing Programs. The change made to the lease is to adopt the following excerpt:

*Not to install any security system(s) (including doorbells) with the exception of health-related equipment and monitors that 1) record audio or video in a common area; or 2) alert emergency responders to a breach of safety or security; or 3) disrupt the right to quiet enjoyment of other tenants.*

This Security System lease provision is hereby posted for comment and will be enacted March 1, 2019.

Residents of or applicants for Public Housing, Low Income Housing Tax Credit (LIHTC), and any member of the Public may submit comments on this Public Housing Dwelling Lease (Part II) change during the public comment period. The 30-day comment period begins January 28, 2019 and ends February 28, 2019 (4:30pm). All comments must be received by 4:30pm on February 28, 2019 to be considered and must be in writing.
